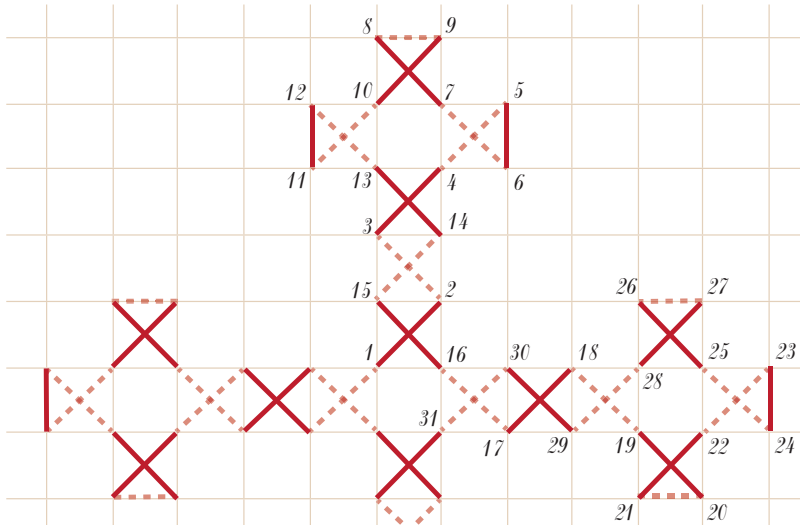
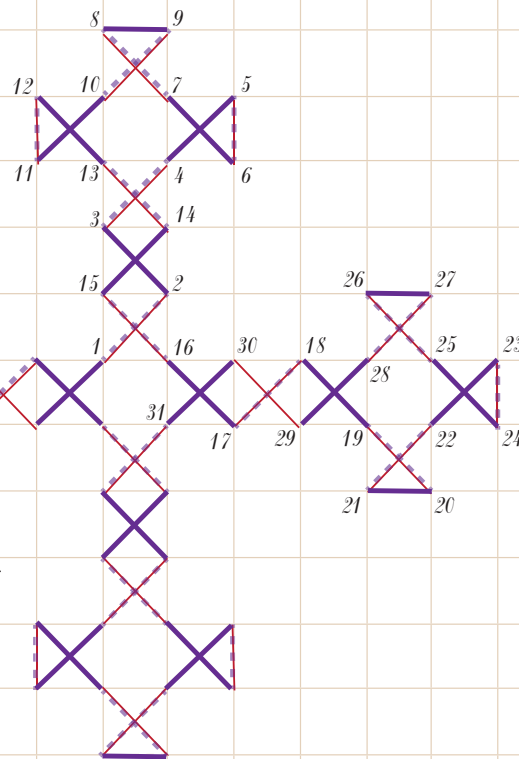


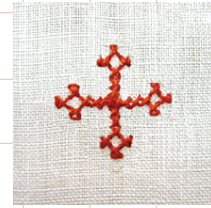
The Reversible Cross



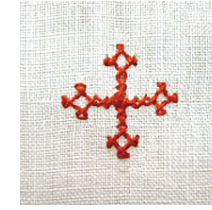
After you finish the top and right lets, rotate the fabric and continue with number 1 to make second half of cross.



At this point your cross looks only half filled in. Run around the cross again putting the back sides on everything



Here is what the finished cross looks like. You can use aida cloth for practice.



And here is what it looks like on the back side.

To finish off the cross, run your thread ends under the three cross stitches on one of the arms and trim it off. If you want a smoother look you can outline the cross.

We usually use a magnifier and count threads to get a really straight and even result. Watch though because warp and weft threads are often slightly different sizes, so you may need to cheat a thread or two to even out the length of the cross arms.
