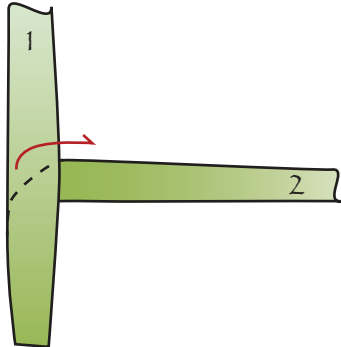


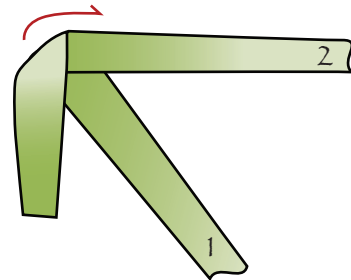
# Palm Rose



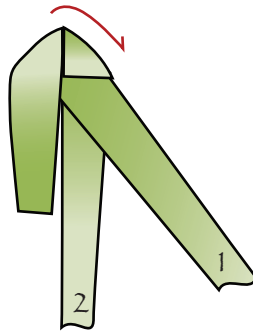
Step 1:  
Take a palm that has two leaves attached together at the bottom. Leaving about three inches, fold the back palm (2) back and to the right 90°.



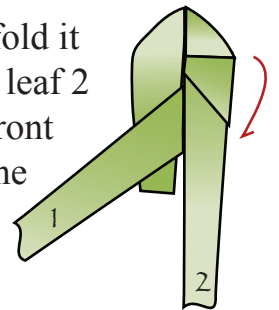
Step 2:  
Next take the front leaf (1) and fold it back over the folded edge of the back leaf so it points to around 5 o'clock.



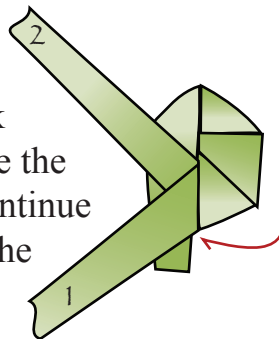
Step 3:  
Now take leaf 2 and fold it back and down behind leaf 1 so it is parallel to the base of the palm where they are both connected.



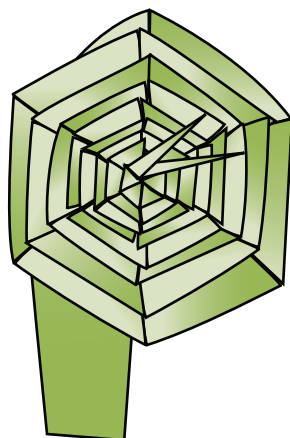
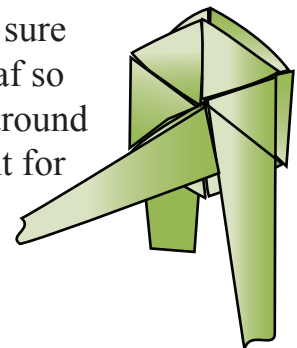
Step 4:  
Then take leaf 1 and fold it back over the edge of leaf 2 bringing it up to the front over the base where the two leaves are connected.



Step 5:  
Next fold leaf 2 back over leaf 1 and above the base of the palm. Continue this until you reach the end of the palms.



Like so. Make sure to fold each leaf so that it rotates around the center point for a nice even rose.



When you run out of palm. Just leave the tiny ends, If they get too narrow to keep going trim them neatly and call it a day.
